Notes: Number 1 already has an AGM, Numbers 1-3 are very old clones, clearly closely related, Number 4 is of known, fairly recent origin in Denmark, Number 5 probably arose at Branklyn Garden, Numbers 6 and 7 are clearly closely related, Number 8 is another old cultivar and clearly quite distinct from any others.

Numbers 13-16 are clearly closely related and very similar, but we feel they are distinct, this applying to constitution and not just appearance – some seem to “do” better in certain climates than others.

Number 19 is reliably fertile, producing masses of seed. Numbers 20 and 21 were raised from Seed exchange seed, presumably with 'Lingholm' affinities, but 20 does not produce viable seed and 21 does not do so reliably – they are both to be treated as clonal cultivars. Number 22 we believe to be true grandis and it produces full capsules of viable seed. Number 23 appears to be true grandis (we understand ex one of the collections of Polunin, Sykes and Williams), but it is sterile.
